HELP will deal with this challenge.

HELP is a modular, adequate, homogeneous, media supported training programme, based on CEFR standards to satisfy demands of learner-centred formal and informal learning approaches for the English levels B1/B2 and development of intercultural competences for training centres and learning at the workplace.

HELP is going to overcome the patchwork of educational materials and approaches which is used for English training in healthcare. We are going to create a training programme, in line with latest developments concerning the professional content and requirements for the European workplace and taking up potentials from media support for learning with mobile devices, connecting education and workplace.

THE AIM IS TO CREATE AN INNOVATIVE STANDARD LEARNING SETTING FOR HEALTHCARE ENGLISH LEARNERS AND PROFESSIONALS AT THE LEVELS B1 AND B2 OF THE CEFR. THAT SATISFIES A DEMAND ON NATIONAL AND EUROPEAN LEVELS.

# For whom we offer HELP?

The programme is for everyone who wants or needs to work on communication skills for healthcare, care for elderly and healthcare tourism.

We are going to develop a learning programme for:

- professionals working as nurses, in elderly care taking and other healthcare profession, organised or individually, and that have a need of further learning, formal and/or informal, in order to meet the workplace needs
- Universities, Medical High schools and Language Centres, European language teachers who teach English for Medical Purposes;
